AMENDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 117 DATED APRIL 14, 1968,  
CREATING A NATIONAL COMMITTEE TO TAKE CHARGE OF THE  
CELEBRATION OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE DAY ON  
JUNE 12, 1968.

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, I, FERDINAND  
E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, hereby amend Executive  
Order No. 117, dated April 14, 1968, creating a National  
Committee to take charge of the celebration of Philippine  
Independence day on June 12, 1968, to include the following

Local Governments.


The Director, National Museum
