EXECUTIVE ORDER }
No. 57. }

Pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and sub-provinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," I hereby transfer that part of the municipality of Bauang, Province of La Union, commonly known as the barrios of Pagudpud, Pagdalagan, Sevilla, Bungro, Tanquigan, and Siboa-oton, from said municipality of Bauang to the municipality of San Fernando, said province.

The municipality of Bauang shall consist of the territory heretofore comprised therein less the barrios of Pagudpud, Pagdalagan, Sevilla, Bungro, Tanquigan, and Siboa-oton. The municipality of San Fernando shall consist of its present territory plus the territory heretofore comprised, in the barrios of Pagudpud, Pagdalagan, Sevilla, Bungro, Tanquigan, and Siboa-oton, hitherto a part of the municipality of Bauang.

The transfer herein made shall be effective on January first, nineteen hundred and fourteen.
