## AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF A VALUE ORIENTATION WORKSHOP (VOW) FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT

Public service is a public trust. It has always been better said than done. There are doubts as to how the public servants can gain the confidence and trust of the public when values expected of the former have been dripping down or are hardly visible as they carry out their functions.

Participants are to be detached from their official functions for the duration of the course.
