PROCLAMATION NO. 388

RESERVING FOR SCHOOL SITE PURPOSES A CERTAIN PARCEL OF  
LAND OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN SITUATED IN THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF MALABON, PROVINCE OF RIZAL,  
ISLAND OF LUZON.

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of Agriculture and  
Natural Resources and pursuant to the authority vested in me  
by law, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines,  
do hereby withdraw from sale or settlement and reserve for  
school site purposes under the administration of the  
Director of Public Schools, subject to private rights, if  
any there be, a certain parcel of land of the public domain  
situated in the municipality of Malabon, Province of Rizal,  
island of Luzon, more particularly described as follows:

Block 8, Gwo-40720  
Proposed Proclamation for  
SCHOOL SITE

A PARCEL OF LAND (the proposed SCHOOL SITE),  
situated in the Barrio of Pañong, Municipality of  
Malabon, Province of Rizal. Bounded on the SW.,  
NW. and NE., along lines 1-2-3-4-5-6, by Proposed  
Road, and on the SE., along line 6-1, by Malabon  
River. Beginning at a point marked "1" on the  
attached Sketch Plan, being S. 24 deg. 37' E.,  
657.57 m. from B.L.L.M. 1, Twp. of Malabon, Rizal,

thence N. 34 deg. 15' W., 39.48 m. to point 2;  
thence N. 9 deg. 41' E., 2.14 m. to point 3;  
thence N. 48 deg. 22' E., 64.20 m. to point 4;  
thence S. 68 deg. 01' E., 1.12 m. to point 5;  
thence S. 32 deg. 57' E., 57.84 m. to point 6;  
thence S. 64 deg. 07' W., 65.15 m. to the point of

beginning; containing an area of THREE THOUSAND TWO  
HUNDRED FORTY FOUR (3,244) Square Meters. All points  
referred to are indicated on the attached Sketch Plan.

NOTE: All data are approximate and subject to change based on future survey.
