PROCLAMATION NO. 148

DECLARING MARCH 9, 1993, AS LAUREL DAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, March 9, 1993, marks the 102nd birth anniversary of the late Jose P. Laurel, eminent, jurist, legislator, administrator, writer, lawyer, educator and statesman;

WHEREAS, Jose P. Laurel dedicated service to the three branches of our government has left a tangible imprints of human values deserve to be emulated;

WHEREAS, Jose P. Laurel as president of the country during the War years inspired the Filipino people the importance of nationalism;


