PROCLAMATION NO. 296

DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF CALAMITY IN THE MUNI-CIPALITY OF COLUMBIO, PROVINCE OF SULTAN KUDARAT

WHEREAS, according to the Secretary of National Defense, as Chairman of the National Disaster Coordinating Council, the Municipality of Columbio, Province of Sultan Kudarat, was adversely affected by the harrassment of armed men that resulted in the injuries of 18, the death of 4 persons and 1 missing;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for the declaration of a state of public calamity in said area to normalize the situation thereat;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the existence of a state of calamity in the Municipality of Columbio, Province of Sultan Kudarat.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
