PROCLAMATION NO. 1147

**DECLARING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2006, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MALVAR, PROVINCE OF BATANGAS**

**WHEREAS**, Wednesday, September 27, 2006, marks the birth anniversary of General Miguel Malvar, the last general of the Philippine Revolution to surrender to the Americans;


