PROCLAMATION NO. 1150

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, 18 FEBRUARY 2026, A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)
DAY IN THE CITY OF BAYAWAN, PROVINCE OF NEGROS ORIENTAL
